Sabarmati Ashram the symbol of Gandhiji's struggle

2017 marks the Centenary Year of Sabarmati Ashram. This ashram is now a national monument established by the Government of India due to its significance for the Indian independence movement in the form of the Dandi March in 1930.

The Ashram was shifted and established from it's erstwhile Kocharab Bungalow in the year 1917 to a piece of open land on the banks of the river Sabarmati. It was believed that this was ancient ashram site of Dadhichi Rishi who had donated his bones for a righteous war. Mahatma Gandhi said, "This is the right place for our activities to carry on the search for truth and develop fearlessness, for on one side are the iron bolts of the foreigners, and on the other the thunderbolts of Mother Nature."
